Before the appliance is used, it must be properly positioned and installed as described in this manual, please read the manual carefully. To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock or injury when using the appliance, follow basic precautions, including the following:



- Plug into a grounded 3-prong outlet, do not remove grounding prong, do not use an adapter, and do not use an extension cord.
- Do not use if the power supply cord is damaged. If damaged, it must be replaced by a qualified electrician.
- It is recommended that a separate circuit, serving only your appliance be provided. Use receptacles that cannot be turned off by a switch or pull chain.
- Never clean appliance parts with flammable fluids or harsh chemicals. These fumes can create a fire hazard or explosion.

- Do not store or use gasoline or other flammable vapors and liquids in the vicinity of the appliance or any other appliance.
- Before proceeding with cleaning and maintenance operations, make sure to unplug the appliance.
- Do not connect or disconnect the electric plug with wet hands.
- Do not attempt to repair or replace any part of your appliance unless it is specifically recommended in this manual. All other servicing should be referred to a qualified technician.
- This appliance is CFC- and HFC- free and contains small quantities of Isobutane (R600a) which is environmentally friendly, but flammable. It does not damage the ozone layer, nor does it increase the greenhouse effect. Care must be taken during transportation and setting up of the appliance that no parts of the cooling system are damaged. Leaking coolant can ignite and may damage the eyes.

In the event of leakage:

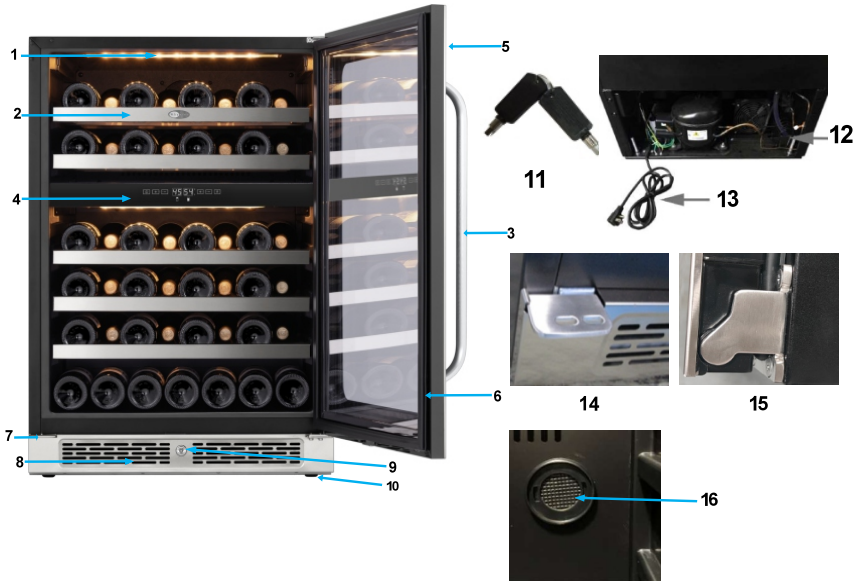
- Avoid open flames and anything which creates a spark
- Disconnect from the mains
- Air the room in which the appliance is located for several minutes and contact the Service Department for advice



FOLLOW WARNING CALL OUTS BELOW ONLY WHEN APPLICABLE TO YOUR MODEL

- Use two or more people to move and install the appliance. Failure to do so can result in injury.
- To ensure proper ventilation for your appliance, the front of the appliance must be completely unobstructed. Choose a well-ventilated area with temperatures above 60°F (16°C) and below 90°F (32°C). This appliance must be installed in an area protected from the element, such as wind, rain, water spray or drips.
- The appliance should not be located next to ovens, grills or other sources of high heat.
- The appliance must be installed with all electrical connections in accordance with state and local codes.
- The fuse (or circuit breaker) size should be 15 amperes.
- It is important for the appliance to be leveled in order to work properly. For a stable installation, make sure the appliance is placed on a flat, level and solid surface.
- Ensure that the surface on which the appliance is placed is strong enough to hold the appliance and the items stored inside.
- This appliance is not intended for use by young children or physically-challenged persons without supervision/ assistance. Young children must be supervised to ensure safety around this or any appliance.
- Do not use solvent-based cleaning agents or abrasives on the interior. These cleaners may damage or discolor the interior.
- Keep fingers out of the "pinch point" areas. Clearance between the doors and between the doors and cabinet are necessarily small. Be careful closing doors when children are in the area.
- This refrigerator is designed to store beverage cans and wine bottles. If food is stored inside, ensure that there is sufficient airflow between items. Please note that the temperature range for this refrigerator is optimized for wine and beverage storage. Perishable food items may require a different storage environment.
- Do not place hot food or beverages into the appliance.
- Close the refrigerator doors immediately after putting in any items to keep the internal temperature relatively constant.
- Avoid placing any objects on top of the appliance.
- This is an electrical appliance, to avoid injury from electrical shock do not operate the unit with wet hands, while standing on a wet surface or while standing in water. Do not use outdoors or in wet conditions.
- When positioning or moving the appliance, ensure that it is not turned up side down or unlevelled greater than 45°
- Never pull the power cord to disconnect it from the outlet. Grasp the plug and pull it from the outlet.
- Never lift, carry or drag the appliance by the power cord.
- This appliance is designed for household, non-commercial use only. Any other use will void the warranty.
- Do not plug into the power outlet before set up is completed.
- Do not move this appliance without emptying it and securing the door in a closed position.

Before Using the Appliance

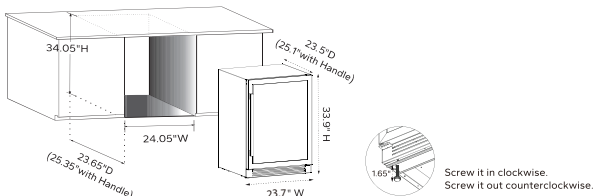
- Remove the exterior and interior packing.
- Before connecting the appliance to the power source, let it stand upright for approximately 4 hours. This will reduce the possibility of a malfunction in the cooling system from handling during transportation.
- Clean the interior surface with lukewarm water using a soft cloth.
- Install the handle on the door.

Installation of the Appliance

- The appliance is designed for built-in, recessed or freestanding installation.
- **WARNING:** Do not store or install the appliance outdoors.
- **CAUTION:** This appliance is designed for storing and cooling wines. Do not store perishable food, medicine or other medical products.
- Place your appliance on a hard and level floor that is strong enough to support it when it is fully loaded.
- We do not recommend installing the appliance on carpet.
- To level your appliance, adjust the leveling legs at the bottom of the appliance if needed.
- For freestanding installation, 5 inches (127mm) of space between the back and sides of the appliance are suggested, which allows the proper air circulation to cool the compressor and condenser. Even for built-in installation, it is a must to keep a ¼" (6.35mm) space on each side and at the top. And the air vent at the front of the appliance must never be covered or blocked in any way.
- **NOTE:** Do NOT install the appliance near an oven or other heating source. Direct sunlight may affect the acrylic coating and heat sources may increase electrical consumption. For best performance, do not install the appliance behind a cabinet door or block the base grille.
- Avoid locating the appliance in area that may be exposed to excessive moisture.
- Plug in the appliance into an exclusive, grounded wall power outlet. Do not under any circumstances cut or remove the third (ground) prong from the power cord. Any questions concerning power and/or grounding should be directed toward a qualified electrician or an authorized service center.

Built-in Cabinet Instructions

- Minimum Width: 24.05"

This appliance is designed for both built-in or freestanding installation. For built-in installation, ensure proper service access and ventilation, allow at least ¼" (6.35mm) space on each side and at the top.

Electrical Connection

WARNING

Improper use of the grounded plug can result in the risk of electrical shock. If the power cord is damaged, have it replaced by a qualified electrician or contact Whynter Service Department

This appliance requires a standard 115/120 Volt AC ~/60Hz electrical ground outlet with three-prong. Have the wall outlet and circuit checked by a qualified electrician to make sure the outlet is properly grounded. The cord should be secured behind the appliance and not left exposed or dangling to prevent accidental injury.

The appliance should always be plugged into its own individual electrical outlet which has a voltage rating that matches the rating label on the appliance. This provides the best performance and also prevent over loading house wiring circuits that could cause a fire hazard from over heated. Never unplug the appliance by pulling the power cord. Always grip the plug firmly and pull straight out from the receptacle. Repair or replace immediately all power cords that have become frayed or otherwise damaged. Do not use a cord that shows cracks or abrasion damage along its length or at either end. When moving the appliance, be careful not to damage the power cord.

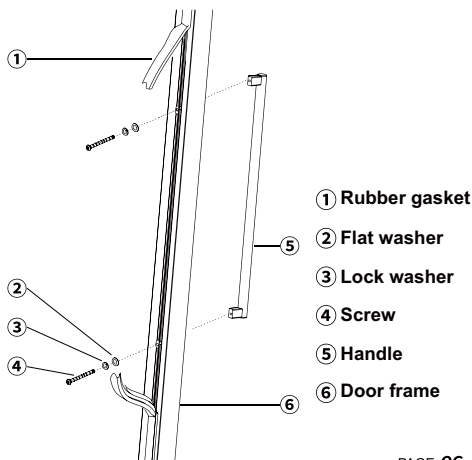
Extension Cord

Because of potential safety hazards, it is strongly recommended that you do not use an extension cord with this appliance. However, if you must use an extension cord, it is absolutely necessary that it be a UL/ CUL-Listed, 3-wire grounding type extension cord having a grounding type of plug and outlet, and that the electrical rating of the cord is 115 volts and at least 10 amperes.

Installing the Handle

This stainless steel handle that is not required for operation. To install the handle please follow the below instructions:

1. Remove door gasket. The gasket can be easily displaced by hand, no tools are necessary.
2. Use a flat-head screwdriver to remove the two pre-installed decorative screw covers from the back of the door. Some models have no decorative covers.
3. Install the handle tightly as shown with the two screws, lock washers and flat washers provided. (DO NOT over tighten as this will cause damage to the handle and stainless steel door frame).
4. Replace the door gasket.



Revising the Door

This appliance has the capability of the door opening from either the left or right side. The appliance is delivered to you with the door opening from the left side. Should you desire to reverse the opening direction, please follow the following reversal instructions.

1. Please remove the bottom hinge holder ② by unscrewing the two lock screws. Be careful to hold the glass door firmly after removing the screws. **Please check Figure 1**
2. Gently pull down to remove the glass door from the right top hinge and place it on a padded surface to avoid the risk of damage. **Please check Figure 2**
3. Using a flat-head screwdriver, gently pry up the decorative hinge cover plate on the top left of the unit and the round black decorative cover caps on the upper left side corner of the inside cabinet frame. Use them to cover the screw holes on the right-hand side. **Please check Figure 2**
4. Move the top hinge from the right-hand side to and use the upper right hinge that is equipped along with the manual in the cabinet to install on the left side of cabinet by removing the screws ⑦. **Please check Figure 3/4**
5. Relocate the door to the left-hand side of cabinet by placing the door hinge holes into the hinge, then screw the bottom hinge assembly with the lower hinge fixer ④ onto the left designated position and tighten after the door is leveled. **Please check Figure 4**

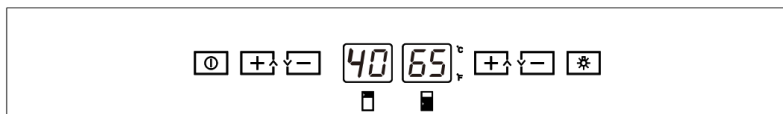



It is recommended you install the appliance in a place where the ambient temperature is between 72°-78°F / 23°C - 26°C, if the ambient temperature is above or below recommended temperatures, the performance of the wine refrigerator may be affected. For example, placing your appliance in extreme cold or hot conditions may cause interior temperatures to fluctuate.







Control Panel





- POWER** 

To turn the appliance on/off, press and hold the  key for 5 seconds. Pressing the  key once can switch off the audible alarm when the alarm is on.
- UP** 

To increase (warm) the set temperature by 1°C or 1°F.
- DOWN** 

To decrease (cool) the set temperature by 1°C or 1°F.
- LIGHT** 

Switch between 3 different colors and off, the light color switch option is in white, blue, and amber color.
- DISPLAY**

 is for UPPER temperature zone and  is for LOWER temperature zone.
- When using the wine refrigerator for the first time or restarting after being shut off for a long period of time there may be a few degree variance between the set temperature and the LED readout. This is normal due the length of activation time. The unit should return to normal after running for a few hours.

NOTE: If the appliance is unplugged, encounter power interruption, or turned off, you must wait 3 -5 minutes before restarting the appliance. If attempted to restart before this time delay, the appliance may not start.

Setting the Temperature

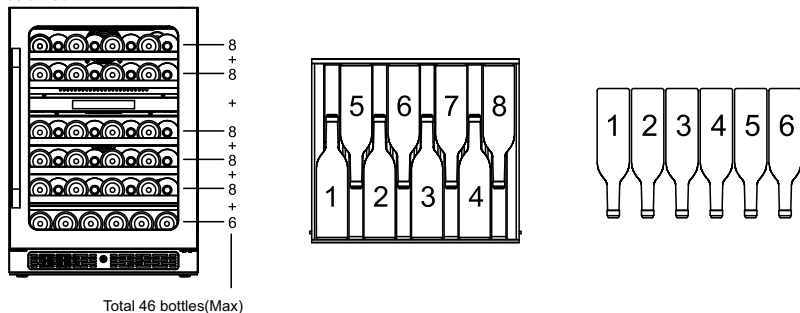
- During normal operation, the temperature display on the control panel shows the temperature inside the appliance.
- The unit has two separate temperature zones. The temperature range of the UPPER zone and the LOWER ZONE is between 40°F and 65°F (5°C and 18°C).
- When the unit is plugged in for the first time, the unit will power up automatically to the preset defaults. The preset temperature for the UPPER temperature zone is 50°F (10°C) and for LOWER temperature zone is 60°F (16°C).
- You can press the UP and DOWN keys to control the internal temperature of the UPPER temperature zone and LOWER temperature zone. To toggle between the UPPER and LOWER temperature zone, press the LIGHT button.
- The temperature that you desire to set will increase 1°C or 1°F if you press the UP key once and will decrease 1°C or 1°F if you press the DOWN key once. The display flashes while you make the setting.
- After the temperature has been set, the display will flash four times before it shows the current internal temperature of the particular temperature zone.
- To view the set temperature at any time, press the UP or DOWN key, the set temperature will temporarily flash in the display for 5 seconds. Then the display shows the current internal temperature.

WARNING

This product is designed for storing and cooling wine. It is not intended for storage of perishable foods.

Large Storage Capacity

While bottles may vary in size and dimension, approximately 46 standard 750ml bottles can be stored in the wine cooler. You can place 8 bottles on each shelf and 6 standard bottles in the bottom of the cabinet.



Door Lock

The appliance is provided with a lock and key combination. The keys are located inside the plastic bag that holds the User Manual. Insert the key into the lock and turn it counterclockwise to unlock the door. To lock the door do the reverse operation making sure metal pin is engaged completely. Remove the key and place it in a secure place.

Shelves

- This appliance is equipped with 5 pcs of wooden shelves and you can move the shelves out and in smoothly.
- To prevent damaging the door gasket, make sure to have the door all the way opened when pulling shelves out of the product. For easy access to the bottles, you must pull the shelves approximately 1/3 out of the cabinet.

Moving Your Appliance

- Remove all items.
- Securely tape down (we recommend using painter's tape) all loose items (shelves) inside your appliance.
- Turn the adjustable leg up to the base to avoid damage.
- Tape (we recommend using painter's tape) the door shut
- Be sure the appliance stays secure in the upright position during transportation and protect the exterior of appliance with a blanket, or similar item.

Cleaning Your Appliance

- Turn off the power, unplug the appliance, and remove all items including shelves.
- Wipe the interior with warm water and baking soda solution. The solution should be about 2 table-spoons of baking soda to one quart of water.
- Wipe the shelves with a mild detergent solution.
- Wipe the outside cabinet with warm water and mild liquid detergent.
- Do not use steel wool or steel brush on the stainless steel. These will erode the stainless steel and rusting may occur.

WARNING

Failure to unplug the appliance could result in electric shock or personal injury

Vacation Time

- Short vacations: Leave the appliance operating during vacations of less than two days.
- Long vacations: If the appliance will not be used for an extended period, remove all items and turn off the appliance. Clean and dry the interior thoroughly.

Premises Power Failure

- In the event of a power interruption, all previous temperature settings are automatically memorized. If power is interrupted (power surge, breaker switch, etc.) and then powered up again, the unit will operate with the last temperature set-point.
- Most power failures are corrected within a few hours and should not affect the temperature of your appliance if you minimize the number of times the door is opened. If the power is going to be off for a longer period of time, you need to take the proper steps by following Troubleshooting Guide to protect your contents.

Activated Carbon Filter System

The Whynter BSR-046DW is equipped with one activated carbon filter, which ensures optimum air quality within the wine cabinet. This filter counters and prevents any contaminants and odors from the ambient air affecting the taste of the wines stored. Replace the activated carbon filter once a year. If you are interested in purchasing an additional charcoal filter, please contact: support@whynter.com for retail sales information.

To change the filter,

- Turn the filter cover 90° clockwise or counterclockwise and then remove the filter.
- Insert the new filter in the vertical position.
- Turn the filter cover 90° clockwise or counterclockwise until it click into position.



Energy Saving Tips

- The appliance should be located in the coolest area of the room, away from heat producing appliances, and out of any direct sunlight.
- Ensure that the appliance is adequately ventilated. Never obstruct the air vents.
- Close the door tightly and do not open the appliance too frequently or for a long period of time.
- Store the content in an organized way.
- Do not over-fill the appliance to allow air to circulate.

You can solve many common wine/ beverage refrigerator problems easily, saving you the cost of a possible service call. Please try the suggestions below to see if you can solve the problem before emailing the service team.

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSE	SOLUTION
Product does not operate.	Not plugged in. The appliance is turned off. The circuit breaker tripped or a blown fuse.	Plug the unit. Turn on the unit. Check the breaker and/or fuses.
Product is not cold enough.	External environment may require a lower temperature setting. The door is opened too often. The door is not closed completely. The door gasket does not seal properly.	Check the temperature control setting. Close the door properly. Check the door gasket.
The compressor turns on and off frequently.	The room temperature is higher than normal. A large amount of contents has been added to the refrigerator. The door is opened too often. The door is not closed completely. The temperature control is not set correctly. The door gasket does not seal properly.	Close the door properly. Check the door gasket.
The fans turn on and off frequently.	The ambient room temperature is too low or high. A large amount of contents has been added to the appliance. The door is opened too often. The door is not closed completely. The door gasket does not seal properly.	Decrease or increase the ambient room temperature. To minimize internal temperature fluctuation, do not add large amount of contents at once. Close the door tightly and do not open the door too frequently or for a long period of time. Ensure the door gasket is not loose.
Fan is always running.	This is simply a function of the cooling system. The lower the setting, the more the fan will run. If the room is very warm, the refrigerator will run more. The unit has been designed to run continuously when operating at the lower temperatures.	If the fan keeps running at a relatively high set temperature. 1. Check the unit is cooling--Wait 15 minutes and check if the fan has stopped. 2. Check the unit is not cooling--Call service center.
The light does not work.	Not plugged in. The circuit breaker tripped or a blown fuse. The light button is "OFF",	Plug the unit. Check the breaker and/or fuses.

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSE	SOLUTION
Appliance shaking.	The wine cooler is not properly leveled.	Check to ensure that the refrigerator is level.
	There is an object under the refrigerator.	Make sure the bottles don't touch each other. Remove the object.
The product seems to make too much noise.	The unit is not level.	Level the refrigerator. The rattling noise may come from the flow of the refrigerant, which is normal. As each cycle ends, you may hear gurgling sounds caused by the flow of refrigerant in your refrigerator. Contraction and expansion of the inside walls may cause popping and crackling noises.
	Frost appears in cabinet (on back).	Either too much humidity or too low of temperature inside cabinet.
The door will not close properly.	The refrigerator is not level.	Level the refrigerator.
	The door was reversed and not properly installed.	Close the door properly.
	The gasket is dirty.	Clean the door gasket.
	The shelves are out of position.	Place the shelves properly.
